EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING MINUTES Date: August 12, 2025

Ernie Sopp serving on behalf of Big SIR, John Eleazarian called the meeting to order at 10:00 am

ATTENDING: Frank Bavarro, Ed Dorn,; Manny Contino,; Duane Evans. Jim Forden; Ted Fox; Roy Grijalva; Bernie Hollenbeck; Bob Large; Nick Lopez; Jackie Lovato;; Roger Stewart; Ernie Sopp; Luis Rodriquez.

CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: Jim Forden introduced chapter member, Bill Prince who has assumed responsibility for the maintenance of our chapter membership records and the publication of the Roster. Bill will be attending future meetings of the BEC to report on the status of membership as well as serve as a resource to the Board.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: MSC to approve.

BIG SIR: 1) Ernie reported that John Eleazarian could not attend today and Chair the meeting, so that he would be serving in that role; 2) Ernie shared with the Board that John had discussed with Bill Prince, the possibility of Bill also assuming responsibility for issuing, recording, and storing of the membership badges. Bill agreed to assume those tasks as well. With this in mind, Ernie called for a Motion that Bill be recognized as a participating member of the SIR 169 BEC. MSC to approve this recognition.

The Checkbook Balance at the end of the period totaled \$7,331.45 Total Cash Available, including Petty Cash of \$100.00, is \$7,431,45 2) Clarification was requested regarding the offer to provide a free luncheon when a new member is inducted. For future reference, when an existing member sponsors a guest who subsequently becomes an inducted member, at the next subsequent luncheon the sponsor's luncheon cost will be assumed by the Chapter. Beyond being an incentive to members to recruit new members, this practice will be also be a reimbursement to the sponsor if he had assumed the cost for the quest's introductory lunch
